REQUIRES AN ENTRY PERMIT.

Pet owners bringing in a pet without a valid entry permit are subject to fees and penalties under 10GCA § 34306.

When and how do I submit my documents?

All pet entry documents can be submitted digitally to quarantine@doag.guam.gov if you have them available. We recommend submitting your documents 2-3 months prior to arrival for review.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

ALL dogs (including services animals) and cats must:

- Appear healthy on arrival
- Present veterinary documentation with a microchip number

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1. Application for entry permit
- 2. Payment of \$65 per pet
- 3. Current and Prior Rabies Certificate
- 4. Vaccination Records
 - Dogs: DHLPP and Bordetella
 - Cats: FVRCP
- 5. Flight Itinerary
- 6. Quarantine Facility Reservation
- 7. FAVN results from CDC approved testing laboratory
- 8.10-Day Health Certificate

INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS

Effective August 1, 2024, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) implemented new dog import guidelines. Additional requirements listed below:

- **Dogs** must be at least 6 months of age
- CDC Dog Import Form
- Certification of Foreign Rabies Vaccination and Microchip form
- Foreign vaccinated animals arriving from a high-risk rabies area will also be required to be revaccinated for rabies prior to release from quarantine in Guam
